TRUE Democracy ?!? a few questions I'd like to ask all the elected politicians in Germany and the EU – and all over the world

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen,

why did you become politicians?

- for the money, the personal gain, celebrity?
- for your people, to fulfil / to realize their wishes;
 to try to shape a "social organism" (=society) in which every individual ideally is able to become what they are meant to be?
 a society representing the creativity and diversity of all its members!
- to help a few company owners to grow rich and be paid by them for your help with the creation of laws and circumstances that allow those companies to become what they want - regardless whether it hurts people or earth?

you emphasize your support for people who are in the streets in Iran asking for freedom and liberty

but do you support the freedom of your own people?

e. g. in Germany, here, the majority of citizens does not want a future with telemedicine, with ever more industry, more new things like e-cars, digital life, weapons, ...

what people want – and: why don't you ask them and then work on realizing their wishes – instead of procrastinating and doing other things [work as one government, not against each other!]

what people want is: simple structures to use the train and bus system, tickets from vending machines and human vendors – additionally to the digital ones; day tickets and monthly ones

day tickets for more flexibility

free bicycles at the train / bus stations, so we can ride a bike while we are in the city and are able to leave it behind when we take the bus home bicycles also near shops and sports facilities,

so we can effectively use public transport to get around

people want a bakery, a butcher's shop, shoemaker, book shop and flower shop, a farmers market, a shop with environmentally friendly clothing and toys, art

centers, community gardens, play areas ... all within walking distance – the way we had it 40 years ago, even 20 years ago

imagine: towns with a variety of shops — people can entertain themselves by window-shopping, strolling along, children will have the opportunity to smell freshly baked bread, to look at so many different things, to touch them, smell, feel, maybe taste a piece of fruit...

people get to know each other, start to care about each other – no more vandalism, destruction, solitude and sadness.

Wouldn't you rather work all together and also together with the citizen initiatives to realize such a community

instead of fighting, accusing each other of mistakes and lack of ability -

I mean: why do you behave/work/act like that? Is that fulfilling for you? - I can't imagine!

for example: now, foreign ministers are welcomed with military show offs, parades, weapons are presented

wouldn't it be so much nicer to welcome foreigners (and I think we should think of them as friends, at least as possible friends – think of them friendly) with a group of children singing songs and dancing or reciting poems? Or artists showing off their creations?

nicer to have smiling faces in streets filled with pedestrians and bicycle riders, with flowers, trees and shrubs along the sidewalks, apple trees, cherry trees, leaves/compost piles in between, water fountains with drinking water, solar panels on the roofs of most buildings and those little shops I've mentioned before

 city life in the city and easy bus/train connections and lots of untouched nature to relax outside the cities.

You know, you can easily fulfil/realize those wishes when you support the necessary structures, give tax money to the little shop owners, to communities which establish a helper team to convert old derelict houses into community bakeries, butchers, textile shops...

it has been done with laws to fight the SARS-pandemic. Very fast, very quick you gave directions, made laws, enforced them

now you can do the same with little farms, co-ops, citizen initiatives etc. people would like that

you would actually do what you (in my understanding of "democracy") are meant to do, what you've promised to do as democratically elected politicians to realize the wishes of the people

So, please, for more suggestions, read on <u>and</u> accept your role, it is important!

Let's initiate more surveys and citizen votes on big issues like: which kind of transportation system/tickets do people want, do they want to use tax money for project X, do they want a bakery in walking distance, a dentist office ... ??? more electromagnetic radiation? 5G? cars without drivers? or do they want simple structures and PEACE??!!!

The last 20 years have not brought more happiness to people – on the contrary!

Life got more complicated, so much more stressful and dangerous

less trust, less interaction, less freedom, less variety

we are on a track that is focused on electronics, food – but not naturally grown, it's an industry product – entertainment …

faster, faster, more data, more decisions, more worries

And why? What for? What's the big plan behind it? The goal? Where's that path leading us to?

Can you answer these questions?

And do your answers bring harmony to the world – or fight and rivalry and gain – greed?

How does that feel?

Do you like to be involved in that system?

I do not.

and I say: we can choose!

we realize that 20 years of electromagnetic radiation made plants, animals and us sick, that industrialization takes away the sense we would feel if we worked not only on parts of a production process,

we acknowledge that our way of life with transporting goods and animals from here to there and there to here to keep the money going round means a waste of resources and energy –

well, then, **let's change it!**

Think, imagine, use your creative powers!

we could all together create a new way of living together; not like now with politicians trying to establish their ideas, their plans - no -

a really fulfilling, soul-inspired way of living together – worldwide – where everyone can participate, because we decide locally how we want to live, we

discuss what we would need – really need, who could how and where produce it as earth-friendly as possible;

the money system always means problems, like corruption, greed, inequality ... without money – no gain – simple! Imagine - : free!
